Overview of Conference Proceedings Instructions

Thank you for your interest in preparing an extended abstract for the proceedings volume of The 8th International Conference on Solid → Solid Phase Transformations in Inorganic Materials (PTM2020). The following overview may assist authors with some of the most common questions about submitting an extended abstract.

About the Publication

All the accepted extended abstracts will be published in the conference proceedings which will be released to the public by China Machine Press and will be available at the conference beginning on 28 June 2020.

Deadlines

- The deadline for final, publication-ready extended abstracts is **31 January 2020**.

Page Limits

- Plenary paper: 6 pages at the maximum
- Invited paper : 4 pages at the maximum
- Contributed paper: 2 pages

Formatting: All Publications

The volume of PTM2020 will be published in one-column format, so please use the one-column template and instructions the follow. For all proceedings extended abstracts, please use these tips to avoid common formatting errors:

1. Extended Abstract

The composition of extended abstract should be the following: title, authors' names, affiliations, abstract, key words, introduction, body of paper, conclusions, references. See details in attached format sample.

2. Typing

The extended abstracts should be typewritten or printed by laser printer on only one side of each standard A4 sheet and paginated throughout (including the abstract, figure captions, tables, and reference section). The printing should be in one column in good book face of 10.5 p in total of 46 lines. The margins for the page are 30 mm from upper and 20 from bottom edges, left edges and right edges.

3. Figures

The words, letters and symbols in figures should be in 7.5 p, the vector and matrix in bold; and axis captions in coordinate graphics should be complete and should include measure words, units and symbols.

4. Tables

There should be only one table per sheet, with numbers and titles placed above the tables, with three lines and auxiliary lines if necessary.

5. Symbols

The symbols showing physic quantities, letters identifying points, lines and plans should be in italics.

6. References

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References should be numbered in the order they are mentioned in the text. The reference section should be as the style shown below.

- Paper in a journal:

- Authored book:

- Paper in conference proceedings:
[3] MA Tingxi, LU Xueshu. Computer aided analysis of the penetration of mounted tillage implement[A]. Zhang Wei, Guo Peiyu, Zhang Senwen eds. Agricultural Engineering and Rural Development [C]. Beijing: International Academic Publishers, 1992: 157-163.

Note: PowerPoint slides are not acceptable for the conference proceedings publication and should not be submitted.

References

All proceedings extended abstracts should include a references section. Each reference must include complete information about the source material.

Submitting Your Extended Abstract

Extended abstracts should be submitted in both MS Word and PDF format.
