

The ICCN 2019: Call for Abstracts

The 3rd International Congress of Chinese Nephrologists (ICCN) will be held on December 5 - 8, 2019, in Nanjing, China. On behalf of the International Association of Chinese Nephrologists (IACN) and the Nephrology Branch of the Jiangsu Medical Association, we invite submissions from those interested in presenting oral papers and posters at the ICCN 2019.

Abstract Guidelines:

- 1. All types of nephrology-related research are eligible for submission and should address scientific questions, detail clinical observations, or contain preliminary scientific data. Abstracts are NOT eligible for consideration if the research will have been presented (oral or poster) at another meeting or press conference prior to the ICCN meeting. Abstracts are NOT eligible for consideration if the research has been published or accepted for publication by Jan 1, 2019.
- The deadline for submission of abstracts is October 10, 2019.
 Abstracts received after the closure date will not be accepted.
- 3. Abstracts must have a maximum of 1000 words. Word count does not include title or authors and affiliations; all numbers are included in the word count. For original research articles should include the following

subheadings: Aim, Background, Methods, and Results & Conclusions.

Do not include figures and tables.

- 4. To be selected to present you are required to submit an abstract via the congress website (http://iccn2019.medmeeting.org/cn). All abstracts must be submitted electronically. Faxed or hard copy submissions will not be accepted.
- 5. A lead author must be assigned for each abstract submission.

 Generally, this individual is the first author listed in the submission and has the primary responsibility for communications with ICCN.
