## 云南简况

云南位于中国西南，是一个集边疆、民族、山区为一体的省份。全省国土面积 39.4 万平方公里，人口 4800 万，有 16 个州（市）、129 个县（市区）。云南资源丰富，素有“动物王国”“植物王国”“花卉之乡”“药材之乡”和“生物资源基因库”等美称。民族文化浓郁，有 25 个少数民族，其中 15 个为云南独有，是中国少数民族种类最多的省份。区位优势明显，与缅甸、越南、老挝 3 国接壤，边界线长达 4060 公里，是中国通往南亚东南亚的重要门户和古代丝绸之路的必经之地。

当前，全省上下正紧紧围绕习近平总书记要把云南建设“成为我国民族团结进步示范区、生态文明建设排头兵、面向南亚东南亚辐射中心”的目标要求，着力发展壮大 8 大重点产业，全力打造世界一流“绿色能源”“绿色食品”“健康生活目的地”三张牌，大力实施乡村振兴战略，加快产业转型升级，全面深化改革开放，努力走出一条高质量跨越式发展道路。

## 云南教育

云南全省有各级各类高校 81 所，高等教育在校学生 105.8 万人，高等教育毛入学率达到 37.7%；全省高校建有一批国家重点实验室、国际科技合作基地、国际联合实验室。云南大学的化学、微生物学、植物与动物学，昆明理工大学的工程学、材料科学与工程，昆明医科大学的临床医学，云南农业大学的植物与动物学 7 个学科进入 ESI 全球排名前 1%，104 个学科进入全国前 70%。2018 年 9 月，云南大学正式进入国家世界一流大学和一流学科建设行列。云南高校建成博士学位授予单位 9 所、硕士学位授予单位 12 所、服务国家特殊需求硕士人才培养单位 1 所，拥有博士学位授权一级学科点 60 个、专业博士授权点 3 个、硕士学位授权一级学科点 190 个、硕士专业学位授权点 144 个，高层次人才培养影响力正在不断形成，南亚东南亚语种人才培养已成为云南高等教育改革发展的一大亮点。

截至 2018 年底，全省共有幼儿园 7310 所，在园幼儿 131.5 万人，专任教师 53730 人。学前教育三年毛入园率 68.27%。

义务教育阶段学校 13343 所，在校生 565.8 万人，专任教

师 35.4 万人，九年义务教育巩固率 93.5%。其中，小学 11673 所，教学点 3308 个，在校生 376.6 万人，专任教师 22.7 万人，专任教师学历合格率 99.64%，小学生师比 16.59:1，小学学龄儿童净入学率 99.73%。初中学校 1670 所，在校生 187.2 万人，专任教师 12.65 万人，专任教师学历合格率 99.54%，生师比 14.8:1，初中阶段毛入学率 106.9%，初中毕业生升学率 87.45%。

普通高中 480 所，在校生 80.58 万，专任教师 53875 人，专任教师学历合格率 98.02%，生师比 14.96:1，高中阶段毛入学率 82.6%，普通高中毕业生升学率 79.39%。

特殊教育学校 61 所，残疾儿童在校生 27690 人，其中在特殊教育学校 7920 人，随班就读 19770 人，专任教师 1512 人，残疾儿童义务教育阶段入学率 94.7%。

校舍建筑面积和教学行政用房面积分别为幼儿园 773 万平方米、595 万平方米，普通小学 3130 万平方米、1689 万平方米，初中 1885 万平方、789 万平方米，高中 1603 万平方米、731 万平方米。教学设备仪器值分别为小学 35.37 亿元，初中 20.08 亿元，高中 17.45 亿元。



## 云南教育国际交流与合作简况

近年来，云南省积极开展教育国际交流与合作，大力推进“一带一路”倡议和面向南亚东南亚教育辐射中心建设。2018年全省高校招收外国留学生1.93万人，排名全国第9，每年公派出国留学600余人，在境外举办孔子学院15所，中外合作办学项目31项，境外办学项目15项，在建国别区域研究中心38个。由于云南独有的区位优势、人文优势和教育特色，中国教育部将云南列为“一带一路”教育行动计划合作单位，与云南签订了“一带一路”教育行动国际合作备忘录，在经费、政策和机制建设方面给予云南帮助和支持，支持云南开展更大范围、更高水平、更深层次的教育国际交流与合作。下一步，云南省将重点在深化人文交流、推进民心相通、国际化高层次创新人才培养、高质量合作办学、境外办学等方面开展工作，推进教育国际交流与合作迈上新台阶。

## **A Brief Introduction to Yunnan**

Located in southwest China, Yunnan is a province known for its frontier, ethnic groups and mountainous areas. It covers an area of 394,000 square kilometers, with a population of 48 million residing in 16 prefectures (cities) and 129 counties (urban areas). Yunnan is rich in resources, accoladed as "animal kingdom", "plant kingdom", "flower town", "medicine town" and "biological resources gene bank" and so on. With a rich ethnic culture contributed by 25 ethnic minorities in Yunnan, among which 15 are unique to it, Yunnan enjoys the most diversity in terms of ethnic minorities in China. Yunnan holds obvious geographical advantages by sharing borders as long as 4,060 kilometers with Myanmar, Vietnam and Laos, and is considered as an important gateway from China to south and southeast Asia and an inescapable part of the ancient silk road.

At present, the entire province is set on a path to become China's National Unity Progress Demonstration Area, Ecological Civilization Construction Vanguard and Radiation Center facing South Asia and Southeast Asia, as put forward by General Secretary Xi, and focuses on developing eight key industries to build itself as a destination of world-class "green energy" "green food" and "healthy lifestyle". Meanwhile, as a strategy of rejuvenating the countryside is being pursued along with speedy industrial transformation and upgrading, Yunnan aims to deepen reform and opening up comprehensively, in hope of blazing a trail in the path of high quality development by leaps and bounds.



## Yunnan' s Education

There are 81 colleges and universities of various levels and types in Yunnan province, hosting 1.058 million students, pushing the gross enrollment rate of higher education to 37.7%. They are also home to a number of state key laboratories, international science and technology cooperation bases, international joint laboratories. Chemistry, microbiology, plant and zoology in Yunnan university, engineering, material science and engineering in Kunming university of science and technology, clinical medicine in Kunming medical university, and plant and zoology in Yunnan agricultural university all rank in top 1% in the world and 104 disciplines rank in top 70% in China. In September 2018, Yunnan university officially entered the ranks of national world-class universities and first-class discipline construction. Among all the Yunnan higher education institutions, 9 of them are authorized to grant doctorate degrees and 12 of them offer master's degrees including 1 master degree program designed for national special needs. Together they offer 60 doctor's degrees in first-level disciplines, 3 professional doctor's degrees, 190 master's degrees in first-level disciplines, and 144 professional master's degrees. This cultivation of high-level talent training is felt widely in the province and as a highlight of the reform and development of Yunnan' s higher education, the cultivation of talents in South and Southeast Asian languages is also well noted.

By the end of 2018, Yunnan recorded 7,310 kindergartens, with 1.315 million children enrolled and 53,730 full-time teachers in them. The gross enrollment rate of three-year preschool education was 68.27%.

In terms of compulsory education, 13,343 schools host 5,658,000 students and 354,000 full-time teachers. The retention rate for nine-year compulsory education reached 93.5% . Among them, there are 11,673 primary schools, 3,308 teaching centers, 3.766 million students, 227,000 full-time teachers, a 99.64% degree qualification rate of full-time teachers, a students-teachers ratio of 16.59:1, and a 99.73% net enrollment rate of primary school-age children. The number of junior middle schools is 1,670, with 1.872 million students and 126,500 full-time teachers. The degree qualification rate of full-time teachers is 99.54%, and

the students–teachers ratio is 14.8:1. The gross enrollment rate of junior middle schools is 106.9%, and the graduation rate of junior middle school graduates is 87.45%.

In the stage of senior high schools, there are 480 of them with 805,800 students, 53,875 full–time teachers, a degree qualification rate of 98.02%, a students–teachers ratio of 14.96:1, a gross enrollment rate of 82.6% for senior high schools, and a graduation rate of 79.39% for standard high school graduates.

There are also 61 special education schools, with 27,690 disabled children students enrolled, including 7,920 students studying in designated special education schools and 19,770 students sitting in standard classes. 1,512 full–time teachers are working for them and the enrollment rate of compulsory education for disabled children is 94.7%.

The construction areas of the school teaching buildings and the buildings for administrative and other auxiliary purposes are respectively 7.73 million square meters and 5.95 million square meters for kindergartens; 31.3 million square meters and 16.89 million square meters for standard primary schools; 18.85 million square meters and 7.89 million square meters for junior middle schools, 16.03 million square meters and 7.31 million square meters for senior high schools. The value of teaching equipments stood at 3.537 billion yuan for primary schools, 2.08 billion yuan for junior middle schools and 1.745 billion yuan for senior high schools.

## **An overview of International Cooperation in Yunnan's Education**

In recent years, Yunnan has ramped up its efforts in its international cooperation in education, in accordance with the Belt and Road Initiative and building Yunnan as a radiating centre for South Asia and South East Asia. In 2018 alone, 193,000 overseas students were enrolled in universities in Yunnan, making Yunnan No. 9 most popular destinations for overseas students in China. Over 600 candidates were sent to study overseas from Yunnan at public expenses. As of now, 15 Confucius Institutes have been established. along with 31 joint programs in Chinese–Foreign Cooperation in Running Schools, 15 overseas programs established by Yunnan universities and 38 centers of area studies. Given its unique advantages in geographic locations, cultures and education, the Ministry of Education in China signed an MOU with Yunnan regarding cooperation in the internationalization in education in the context of BRI, listing it as a partner in these collaborative efforts. This is bound to help Yunnan conduct its internationalization with a bigger scope, on a higher level, in more depth in terms of funding, policies and constructions of working mechanisms. Moving forward, Yunnan is to focus on deepening cultural exchanges, public diplomacies, cultivation of high end talents, top quality joint programs, establishment of overseas programs, in hope of achieving yet another milestone in its long term goal of international cooperation.
